## 1-2-3 Quilt, Toddler ~ Child

This is an easy to make quilt. It is made up of 30 blocks. This kit includes 10 blocks of a juvenile theme fabric and 10 blocks each of 2 coordinating fabrics. All 30 blocks are cut into 8 " square blocks. It needs no border.

Fabric requirements:
Color 1 [focus fabric] - ½ yard x $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide, cut into ten -8 " squares.
Color 2 [coordinate] $-1 / 2$ yard $\times 42^{\prime \prime}$, wide, cut into ten $-8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Color 3 [coordinate] $-1 / 2$ yard $\times 42^{\prime \prime}$, wide, cut into ten $-8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Backing - $40^{\prime \prime} \times 48^{\prime \prime}$

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\text { Batting - } 40^{\prime \prime} \times 48^{\prime \prime}
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Using a $1 / 4$ " seam for construction, sew 6 rows using layout as shown. Press seams using ease of construction. Sew the 6 rows together and press seams using ease of construction.

This blanket can be finished using the traditional method, which uses a binding, or the 'envelope' method, which uses no binding. Quilt or tie at least every $31 / 2$ to 4 inches. Quilting on the diagonal at all intersections looks nice and reinforces the blanket. Quilting $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ around the outside edges gives a more finished look when using the 'envelope' method.

Finished quilt is approximately $371 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 45^{\prime \prime}$.

Tip:
Consistent sizes require sewing using $1 / 4$ " seams.
